Minamiza Theatre is one of the earliest of the seven officially licensed Kabuki theatres built in the early Edo present Kabuki across over 400 years of history. Minamiza Theatre was designated as a Registered Tangible Cultural Property in 1996 and was even registered as a Structure of Historical Design in Kyoto shortly after.

After its large-scale reconstruction to make it earthquake proof, Minamiza Theatre reopened in November, 2018. 


